Physical Hydrology / Hydrogeology Faculty Position

The School of Geosciences, part of the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of South Florida, is seeking to hire a physical hydrologist or hydrogeologist. The successful candidate could have any specialty in the hydrologic sciences, though preference may be given to candidates with strengths in numerical modeling, ecohydrology, shallow geophysics, karst hydrology, coastal processes, contaminant transport, and/or tracer hydrology. The School of Geosciences is an interdisciplinary unit comprised of Geology, Environmental Science and Policy, and Geography, so the ability to interact across traditional disciplinary boundaries is requisite. The successful candidate will be expected to develop an externally funded research program, mentor graduate students, teach undergraduate and/or graduate courses, and continue the School's tradition of strong ties with the professional geoscience community.

The position is a 9-month, tenure-track appointment offered at the Assistant or Associate Professor level, depending upon qualifications. Salary is negotiable. The start date is August 2015.
